

Leppington Lions Terms and Conditions of Registration

Code of Conduct:

All members are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that upholds the values of sportsmanship, fair play, and respect for fellow members, coaches, referees, opponents, and park facilities.

Any behaviour deemed unacceptable, including but not limited to discrimination, harassment, abusive language, physical violence, or disruptive behaviour, may result in disciplinary action, suspension, or termination of membership.

Player Registration Packages include:

Payment: Payment will be taken in full online via the 360Player platform through Stripe, when you fill out the form. Credit Card fees have already been included in the price on the 360Player app portal.

Training

Training is an important aspect of joining a soccer club, skills and game tactics/set up are discussed at these sessions depending on the age group. Your child is expected to attend training. Your manager will send out a reminder on the day of training, please advise as soon as you possible if your child is able to attend or not. If there are instances where there are very minimal numbers the manager may decide to cancel training. If the grounds are closed due to wet weather this will be communicated to you as soon as they can advise. Please ensure your child arrives on time or even 5 minutes earlier with shin pads, boots and a water bottle ready to train. It is a mandatory requirement that all players wear shin pads for any training or game. As a parent please help the coach/ manager with any set up that is involved to get the session started, all equipment is in the equipment container and is shared amongst all teams training with the exception of your own teams labelled ball bag.

Parents are expected to stay and supervise their child during the session.

At the end of the session, players should be encouraged to assist with pack up, along with parents assisting. All equipment is to be returned to the equipment container and stored neatly and ensure all balls are returned.

SHIN GUARD PROTECTION POLICY THE WEARING OF SHIN GUARDS IS MANDATORY Players must wear adequate shin guards at all times when warming up, or playing matches, (competition or otherwise) and also at all times when training. Any player who arrives for a match or training without their shin guards must be excluded from all activities until they have been outfitted with proper shin guard protection. Shin guards must be of a commercial nature (rubber plastic etc) and must be of a size commensurate with the age/size of the player. No person, (Referee, Parent, Committee Member or Team Official) is permitted to absolve a player of the responsibility of wearing shin guards, for any reason.

Game Day Information

This will be communicated to you via your manager by Friday each week at the latest. If your child/ren is unable to attend game day please be courteous and advise your manager as soon as possible as often they have already worked out starting line up/ formations etc and this can cause additional work for them if no notice is provided. In the event of games being washed out your manager will advise on this as soon as any information is received. All players should arrive at the grounds 30 minutes before their game to commence warm up training. Parking can be tricky at some away fields & at our field this season due to road works so please allow enough time to get to the field. When your child/rens team is playing at our home ground - Leppington Oval if your team is the first team for the day please arrive earlier than this to assist with setting up of the fields for your team and then assist other teams if necessary. The earliest games commence at 8:30am.

If you are the last game playing on that field for the day at Leppington Oval please pack up your field and return all equipment back to the equipment container, the container is to be left in a clean and tidy manner at all times. Please ensure your field is left in a clean and tidy manner after all games.

Assistance may be required from parents to help referee games, in most cases junior games will not have a referee provided. Only the coach & manager registered for the team are able to sit on the players bench for match days, all other spectators must remain in the allocated spectator area at all times.

When your child/ren is playing at an away ground please ensure the same respect is given to their fields/areas with all rubbish removed after the game etc.

Game Days at Leppington Oval are a team effort from everyone to ensure things run as smoothly as possible. Southern Districts Soccer Football Association (SDSFA) use the app/website called Dribl. Please ensure you have downloaded this and have set up to follow your child/rens teams for the most up to date information for all game day information. Canteen Duty

All teams will be advised of their canteen duty shifts in advance from their manager, shifts are taken on rotation by all teams when playing at Leppington Oval. Your assistance in advising your manager of when you can help is appreciated, we rely solely on volunteers to run the canteen. It is a mandatory requirement of SDSFA that the canteen be open on game days, otherwise we face a fine from the association. All funds raised through the canteen during the season go towards the end of season presentation day.

Training will be provided on how the canteen operates on your allocated shift time from the Canteen Manager.

Player expectations - please discuss the following with your child/ren

- Wear your uniform with pride, you are representing your club
- Be respectful to your coach/manager at all times
- Respect your home ground and facilities
- Be a team player and good sport by encouraging your team mates
- Respect the decision of officials
- Play by the rules
- Most importantly - Have Fun!!

Parent expectations

- Advise your child's coach/manager if your child is unable to attend training or game days in advance, ensure your child is on time for training and 30 minutes early for game days
- Assist your coach/manager at training sessions for the benefit of the whole team - setting up, packing up, filling in if needed, all parents must be in attendance for the whole training session, children are not to be dropped off and unsupervised
- Ensure your child attends game days in their full uniform, with shin pads and soccer boots. Please also make sure your child brings their water bottle

- Assist your child's coach manager on home game days setting up and packing down the field, ensure you leave your game area clean and tidy after
- Respond to coaches and managers when they request for assistance in the canteen, all teams will need to assist in the canteen throughout the season
- Provide positive comments during training and games which are motivational to your child and all children in the team
- Congratulate all participants on their performance regardless of the outcome of the game
- Respect the decisions of officials and ensure your child does the same
- Encourage your child and their team to always to play according to the rules
- No unruly behaviour will be tolerated at training or games days - please refer to the rules above for spectator behaviour.
- Show appreciation for volunteers - coaches, managers, committee members, without their assistance the club wouldn't be able to run Any questions/queries should be directed to your coach/manager in the first instance. Committee members are present on training nights and game days for assistance as needed.
